## Getting Started

NoveList can be used in many ways. If you are looking for something similar to a book you have already read, one way of looking for similar books is searching NoveList for the title of the book and clicking on the result. To the right of the book description will be **Read-alikes**, books that have similar aspects to the book you are looking at. If you scroll down to the bottom of the page, you will see a section titled **Search for More**. Here you can click on various aspects such as **subject**, **tone**, **storyline**, **location**, **and genre** to search for novels that meet all the requirements you check off.

Want to make your own combo? Try our appeal mixer



Another way of using NoveList involves using their Appeal Mixer, located on the homepage of the database underneath the first set of recommended books.

When you click on the Appeal Mixer, you can first filter by your preferred target age, then choose three categories out of the options of character, pace, illustration, storyline, tone, and writing style. NoveList will then pull up a list of recommendations that fit your selected categories.
